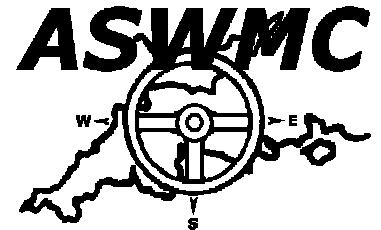
The closing date will be 30th August 2011. After the closing date entries will be accepted subject to numbers, late entry supplement £10. We look forward to receiving your entry.

2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd. (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA). The regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
3. The MSA permit number tba.
4. The event is open to fully elected members of the organising club and members of clubs affiliated to the ASWMC, AEMC & ACSMC Associations, & Richard Egger Insurance Southern Counties Autocross Championship and Home Counties Autocross Championship.
5. The event is a round of the Richard Egger Insurance Southern Counties Autocross Championship CH2011/S077 and the Home Counties Autocross Championship CH2011/S063
6. All competitors must produce a valid club membership card, competition licence and championship registration card (if applicable) at signing on.
7. The programme of the meeting will be on both days:

8. The length of course is approx. 1200 metres per lap and consists of right and left hand bends on a stubble field.

14. The Maximum number of entries for the event is 80 inc reserves. The minimum is 25. The minimum in each class is 3. Should of the above minimum figures not be reached the organisers reserve to either cancel the event or amalgamate the classes as necessary. 16. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event.

17. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with GR.05.

18. Starting order will be determined by class. Cars will start in groups of 4 or 2 & 2, this being the maximum of cars on the course at one time. The start signal will be by flag or lights. The finish line will be denoted by a flag or board.

19. Competitors will have one practice run of 3 laps and a minimum of 3 timed runs of 4 laps, should time permit, 4 timed runs of 4 laps.

20. Competitors will be identified by competition numbers, which will be allocated (but NOT supplied) by the organisers. Identification numbers must be displayed on both sided of the car. Where the car is double driven the numbers not applicable must be completely masked. If this is not done the MSA timekeeper may not give a time and in the case of a re run will NOT be permitted.

21. Marking and penalties will be 5 seconds per penalty marker hit plus as printed of the appropriate section of the MSA regulations. Every marshal is a judge of fact for circuit penalties and the start line marshal will judge for false starts.

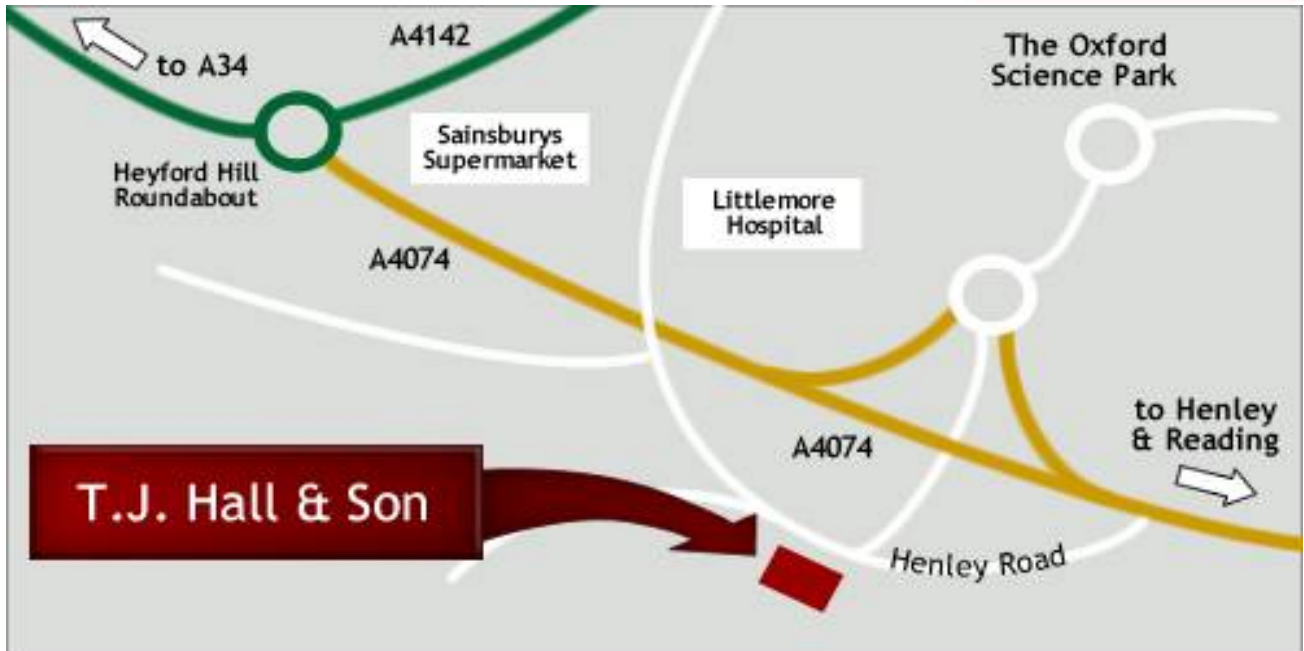
